## NURSING PROGRAM APPLICATION

Thank you for your interest in the Southeast New Mexico College Nursing Program. Nursing is a demanding discipline. We urge you to recognize the commitment that is essential for one to be successful in this program. Prior to making application to the program, individuals should consider carefully the mental and physical demands of the program and unique pressures involved in successful completion of the nursing certificate/degree.

Begin your application as soon as possible to ensure that you meet all the requirements by the deadline.

**There will be no late applications accepted.** Meeting the minimum requirements for admission is no guarantee that you will be accepted. In order to consider your application, the following items must be submitted with your completed packet:

- Current Degree Audit
- **HESI A2 scores.** The Health Education Systems, Inc. test (HESI) is designed to assess the academic and personal readiness of prospective nursing students. **Students must earn a minimum of composite score 75% and a minimum score of 60% on each of the five academic subtests—Math, Reading Comprehension, Vocabulary and General Knowledge, Grammar, and Anatomy and Physiology.** Students are only allowed to take the test **twice** in any twelve month period. The third attempt may be scheduled one year after the second attempt. We will use the attempt with the highest overall score, providing all subtest scores are at least 60%. We will not pick and choose highest subtest scores from different attempts. Test results are valid for one year. It is essential to prepare thoroughly for the HESI. The higher your score, the stronger your application. It is more effective to be prepared and utilize resources specifically to the HESI A2. Several kinds of study materials are available, ranging in price from \$20 – \$100. Locate these by searching online for “HESI A2 preparation”, Amazon, or visit the SENMC library and/or LAC.
- All college transcripts (unofficial are fine)
- If you do not meet admission criteria, or are applying for re-admission and would like consideration, please submit a letter of request to the Admission, Progression & Graduation committee.

In addition, you will need to schedule an advising appointment. Please contact the Nursing Administration office at 575-234-9300 to schedule that appointment. If you have any questions, you may contact the office or your advisor. **Application and all required documents due *No Later Than 5:00 pm, by the second Monday of May.***

Prior to submitting this application, if you have ever been convicted of a felony or declared mentally incompetent, you should contact the Board of Nursing in the state in which you intend to seek licensure.
