Confined Space

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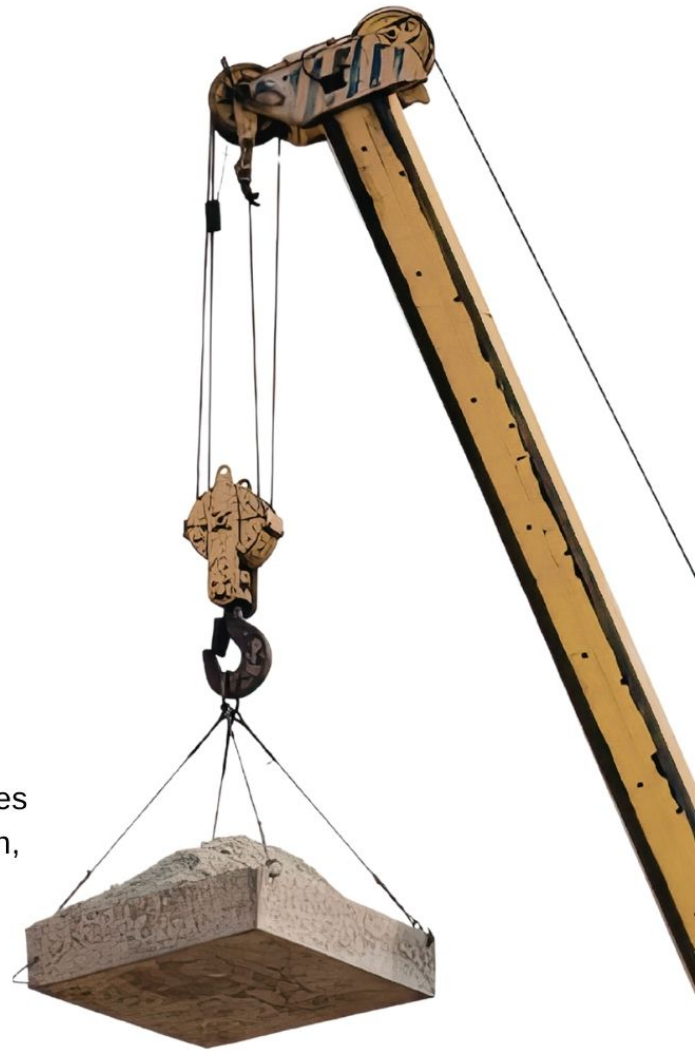
Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Session 1 | Free | July 20 - 24 | 8am - 5pm | 40 Course Hours

Build the Skills Behind Tomorrow's Digital Infrastructure

This five-day course prepares participants to work with structured cabling systems used in broadband, telecommunications, and data networks. Training focuses on industry standards, safe installation practices, and real-world applications used across modern communication systems. Early registration is recommended.

Installer 1 Training (INST1 Certificate):

The introductory course in the BICSI Installation Program. Participants gain foundational skills needed to function safely and effectively on telecommunications installation projects.

Topics include:

- Cable installation fundamentals
- Industry safety practices
- Structured cabling standards
- Installation tools and techniques
- Telecommunications infrastructure basics
